

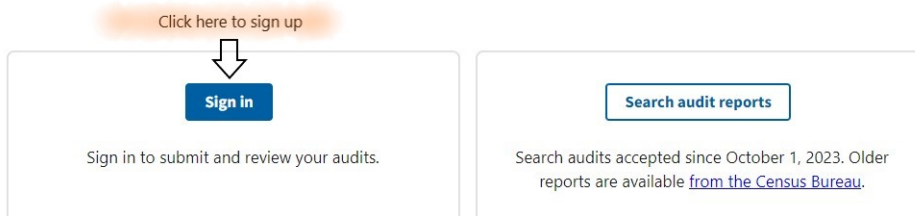
NEW FAC SITE ACCOUNT REGISTRATION

The new website for audit report certifications is www.fac.gov. If you have not done so already, you will have to create a new account and password (credentials from the former site will not transfer over). To create your account, follow the steps below:

- 1) The following is what you will see on the main page, click the **Sign In** link to begin.

The Federal Audit Clearinghouse (FAC) is the place to submit and review federal grant audits.

When an organization spends \$750,000 or more in federal grant funds in a fiscal year, they are required to submit an audit. For more information on the features and development of the new FAC, check out our [Updates page](#).



- 2) The following authentication page will appear. Select **Authenticate with Login.gov**.



- 3) That will prompt the user sign-in page, where you can create your account or login to an existing account. (**Please note:** the new FAC site utilizes 2-step verification login, I recommend signing up with an email and/or phone number that you can easily access)
