



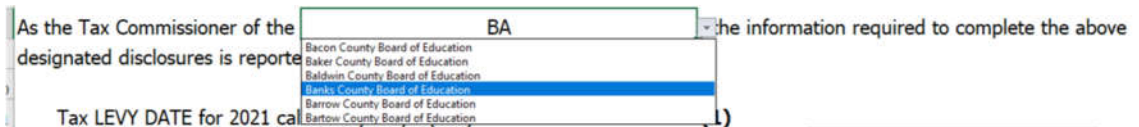

SUBJECT: Property Tax Confirmation

To allow for us to provide clearer guidance to you and better service to our Local Education Authorities (School Districts), made the following changes to the Property Tax Confirmation form for Fiscal Year 2022 and rolled them forward to Fiscal Year 2023 and Fiscal Year 2024.

- 1) We are asking you to complete this form in an Excel and return to us electronically via email. To help facilitate this, we no longer require your signature on this document.
- 2) On the "comm" tab (first page), we have made the following changes.
 - a. A drop-down box with a list of School Districts that you can start typing the name and select. (See below for an example for Banks County Board of Education.)

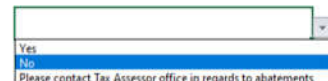


- b. Additional row to enter secondary Due Date. If only one Due Date, please leave blank.
